What is Warehousing and Distribution:

Logistics is the art and science of obtaining, producing, and distributing material and products at the right time, to the right place, at the right cost and in the right quantities.

Elements of Warehousing and Distribution:

Materials management is:

sourcing and receiving of raw materials or unfinished products for subsequent use

Material flow system:

the ability to locate and schedule material through to end production and disposition

Physical distribution:

the delivery of finished goods to customers

Warehousing and Distribution steps:

accepting a customer order

receive and enter

credit clearance / authorize

meeting delivery commitments

supplier ordering

forecasting demand with sales and marketing

scheduling manufacturing

inventory management

delivery to customer.
